

## 2009 County Programs & Star Awards

### GUIDELINES

Judging of awards will be governed by the following guidelines:

1. Each of the program areas will be eligible to earn a certain number of points. Eligibility for a star award in a program area will require a minimum of 80 percent of the total possible points. Counties will be awarded a star award for achievement in the program areas in accordance with the points awarded by the judges.

2. There will be four size categories based on overall county membership.

Category I includes all county Farm Bureaus with up to 275 members:  
Beaver, Garfield, Juab, Kane, Piute, Rich, Wasatch and Wayne

Category II includes all county Farm Bureaus with 276 - 600 members.  
Emery, Iron, Millard, Morgan, San Juan, Sevier, Summit, Tooele, and Uintah

Category III includes all county Farm Bureaus with 601 - 1,100 members.  
No. Box Elder, So. Box Elder, Carbon, Duchesne, and Sanpete

Category IV includes all county Farm Bureaus with more than 1,101 members.  
Cache, Davis, Salt Lake, Utah, Washington, and Weber

3. Based on total accumulation of points from all areas, the top county Farm Bureau in each of these four size categories will receive a plaque presented during the 2009 UFBF Convention.

4. Judging will be based upon actual achievements as described on the application forms submitted by the deadline. Completed application forms must be received in the state office by **Friday, October 31, 2009**.

5. The six programs for competition are:

- Membership Development
- Policy Development
- Policy Implementation
- Womens Programs
- Young Farmers & Ranchers Program
- Safety & Rural Health
